# Michael Toner Discusses Legal Issues Associated With Wooing Convention Delegates

Michael E. Toner, co-chair of Wiley Rein's Election Law & Government Ethics Practice, was quoted in an *ABC News* article about what GOP presidential candidates are legally allowed to offer delegates in exchange for votes.

According to the article, delegates can be offered a role as campaign surrogates or to help develop campaign platforms. Additionally, candidates are able to offer delegates "a role in the administration," but it's potentially problematic to offer delegates a specific federal job in exchange for a vote.

"The candidates will have broad latitude to cut political deals with delegates," Mr. Toner said.
